for our prelude today.

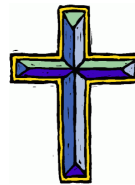
The Breuninger family—

Let's Get Creative!

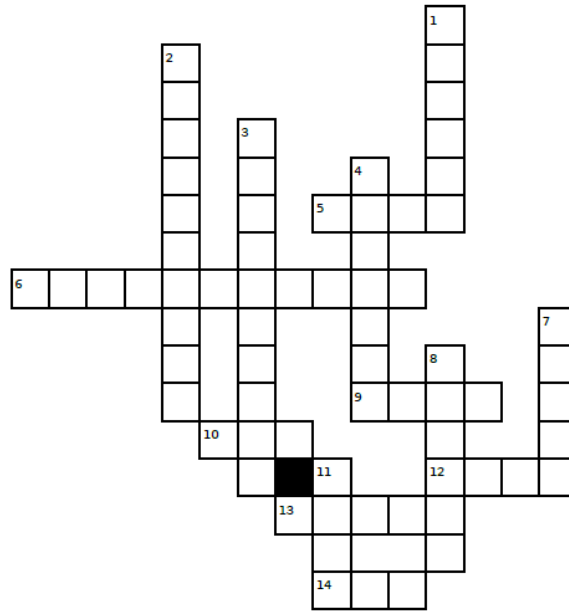
Pastor Caspar will be preaching

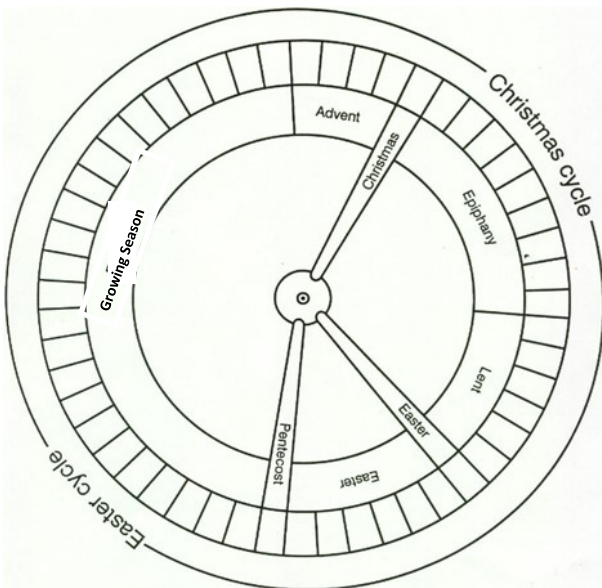
