is our fortress.

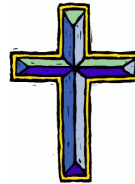
Praise God for being our strength!

POWERFUL

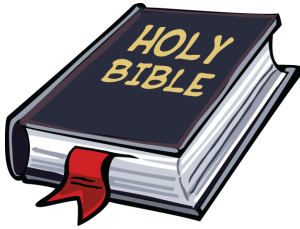
PROTECTING

FAITHFUL

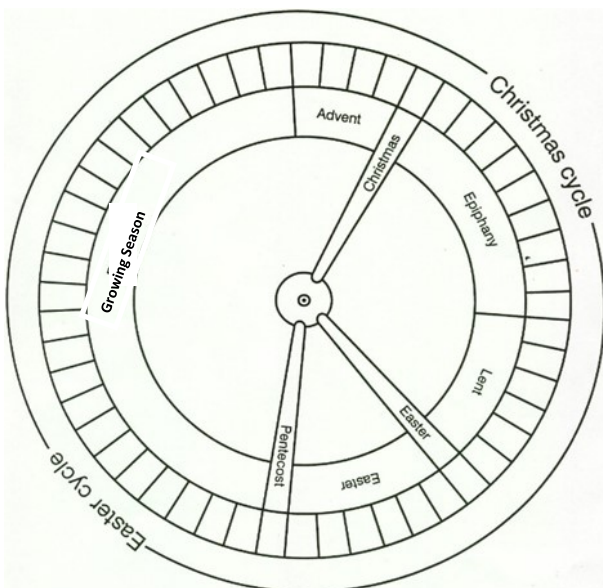
