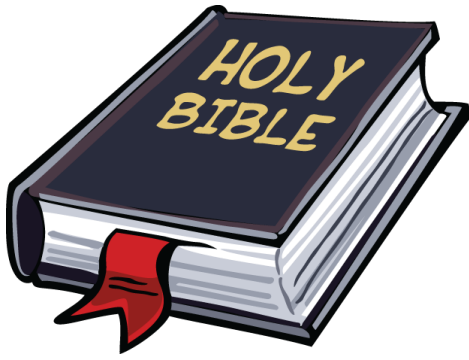
“Great Is Thy Faithfulness!”
