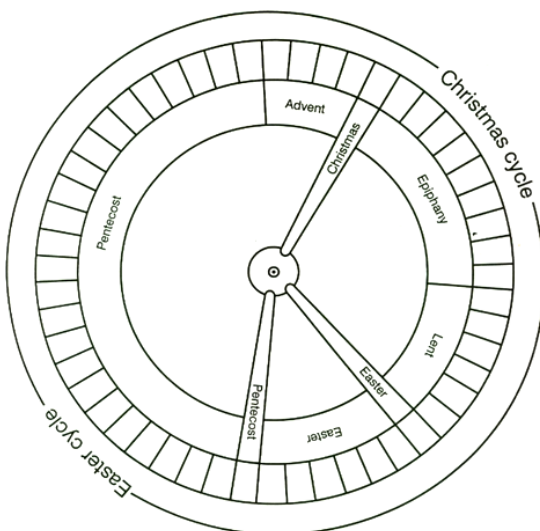


Today is the 4th of July—
