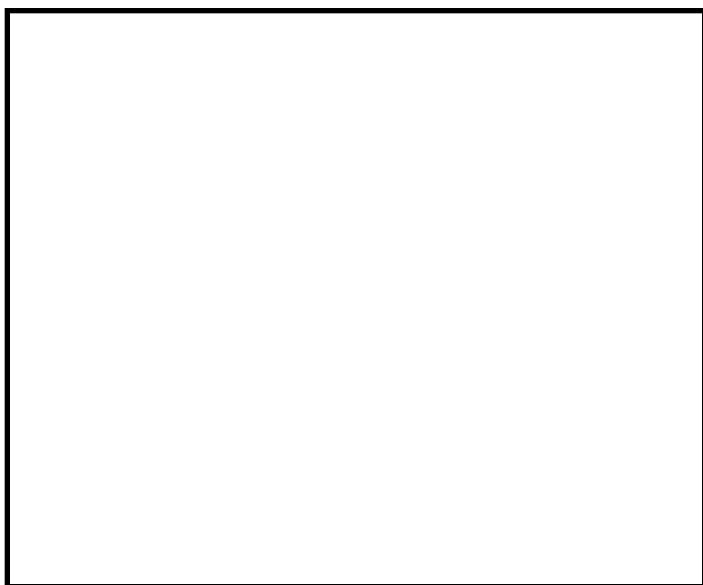


As you begin your worship today,

YOU ... and the whole world?

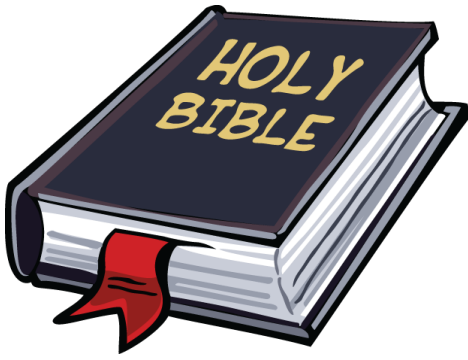
Today is World Communion Sunday.
